Our ThermoFilm process begins with a thin, high-quality urethane film in the color of your choice. Your custom lettering or logo is then CNC cut into the film. We then permanently apply the urethane to the canvas panel. The precision of this process allows crisp, fine lines, perfect lettering, and complex logos that may not be possible with our traditional screening process. This process also eliminates the need for costly screens, saving cost while delivering consistent quality.
